Important reminders regarding school expectations

<u>School Shoes</u> - we have noticed that a number of children are wearing trainers to school. Following our school uniform expectations, please ensure children wear appropriate plain, black school shoes only. If anyone has any concerns regarding costs of school uniform items (including shoes), please contact the school office for support.

<u>Hair Styles</u> - we also need to give further reminders that children should not have excessively shaved (including lines or patterned) hairstyles. Children should not have dyed hair. We have bobbles in school and will issue these to pupils with longer hair where necessary.

Nail Varnish - Please ensure pupils do not wear nail varnish in school.
