
Thank you for your comments:






2. My child feels safe at this school



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


4. This school is a supportive and joyful community

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


7. I understand the school's Catholic mission and I am supportive of it


8. The school supports me in my role as the first educator of my child (As a parent you are the first teacher of your child)


10. I know how well my child is doing in Religious Education and how to improve






11. The school supports my child's spiritual and moral development
